As you are aware, there are 3,894 census towns in India as per the 2011 Census those are with urban characteristics but still are administered as rural areas for delivery of basic civic services. In order to provide an end-to-end solution addressing (i) providing piped water supply within the household premises; (ii) community based rain water harvesting (roof top); (iii) grey¹ water management; (iv) fecal sludge treatment plant for septage² management; and (v) solid waste management, Ministry would be converging current activities under water and sanitation sectors.
