Monthly summary for the month of May, 2025 in respect of Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation

I. Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM)

4.0 Lakhs tap water connections have been provided in the month of May 2025, making it around 12.41 Crore tap water connection since the launch of the Mission in August 2019. As on 31.05.2025, out of 19.36 Crore rural households, around 15.64 Crore (81%) rural households are getting tap water supply.

II. Swachh Bharat Mission – Grameen- Phase – II

2,05,473 Individual Household Latrines (IHHLs) and 1,077 Community Sanitary Complexes (CSCs) have been constructed during May 2025. 7,553 villages have declared themselves ODF Plus during the period. 3,855 villages reported to have been covered with Solid Waste Management and 3,489 villages reported to have been covered with Liquid Waste Management, during the month.

III. Hon'ble Minister of Jal Shakti, Shri C.R. Patil has interacted with Hon'ble MPs on 22nd May, 2025 at Parliament house Annexe, New Delhi regarding points raised by Hon'ble MPs during the Budget discussion on Demands for Grant 2025-26.

IV. Union Minister of Jal Shakti Shri C R Patil launched Swachh Survekshan Grameen (SSG) 2025, on 29th May, 2025, to provide a national ranking of all States/UTs and Districts of India based on quantitative and qualitative sanitation parameters as identified under SBM-II.

V. Secretary, DDWS along with Secretary D/o WR, RD & GR chaired the National Water Mission - Workshop-cum-Orientation Programme for imparting Training to CNOs & TOs for their field visits regarding ground truthing activities proposed under JSA: CTR-2025 on 08.05.2025.

VI. Secretary, DDWS chaired a briefing meeting of Central Nodal Officers (CNOs) and Technical Officers (TOs) for ground inspection of Jal Jeevan Mission schemes on 23.05.2025 at Scope complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi.

VII. Secretary, DDWS chaired a review meeting to assess the implementation of JJM in PM-JANMAN and DA-JGUA villages on 20.05.2025 and laid emphasis on access to safe water to all PVTG households on priority, ground truthing, data reconciliation, monitoring, etc.

VIII. Secretary, DDWS also reviewed the progress and implementation of the Jal Jeevan Mission with DMs/DCs of 24 States/ UTs during the month.
